

Eight diverse buildings are slated for retrofits under the **Rebuild Arkansas** program in Little Rock, including historic Central High School. The partnership “will be a place others can come to learn about cost-effective energy-efficiency measures in a comprehensive group of municipal, institutional, and residential buildings,” said Mark Ginsberg, deputy assistant secretary for the U.S. Department of Energy, at a kick-off celebration in October 1997. The partnership plans to retrofit approximately 700,000 square feet of space in the eight buildings, saving over 20 percent on their energy bills.
