

1500 Days: The Central Ohio Energy Efficiency Project is working with the Foundation for Environmental Education, British Petroleum, American Electric Power, and the Worthington School District to install a solar photovoltaic (PV) system in Bluffsview Elementary School. Bluffsview is the first school to have solar technology installed through the partnership's "Smart School District" initiative. Over the next two years, 1500 Days is looking to retrofit 1.6 million square feet and install PV systems in Worthington's 17 other schools. Greg Viebranz, Worthington's director of communications, praised the program's educational aspects, noting that "students will have access to data about what these solar panels are doing for their school."
