

Rebuild Little Rock gets high

marks...Rebuild Little Rock's participation in the U.S. Department of Energy's "Lighting in the Library" activity was featured in the *Christian Science Monitor* on January 18. The article describes the efforts of ninth graders at Central High School to track energy performance and areas of potential savings. The students are calculating the amount of electricity used to light school libraries and examining the feasibility of investing in energy-efficient lighting fixtures for all five Little Rock high schools. At the end of the school year, the students will present their findings to the Little Rock School Board. Teachers call this a "groundbreaking initiative" that effectively will incorporate an energy component into the existing curriculum and put student recommendations into action.
