



Rebuild Nebraska has completed an energy audit for the Midwest Covenant Home in Stromsburg, Nebraska. The audit of the 95-bed nursing home, built in the 1960s, examined the main building, the newer wings and the administrator's residence on the property. Systems targeted for upgrades include: lighting, the aluminum-frame single-pane windows, the laundry dryer system and the hot water system. Rebuild Nebraska is also working with the
