

A school district that plans to invest \$1.5 million in capital improvements is the newest partner of the **Texas Rebuild/Brazos Valley Energy Conservation Coalition** partnership. The College Station Independent School District (CSISD) represents 11 school buildings with over 915,000 square feet and spends over \$800,000 in utility costs each year. The District plans to achieve annual energy savings of approximately \$183,000 per year through improvements that include: replacing chillers, boilers and DX units; upgrading and replacing lighting in all schools; upgrading energy management controls and other energy management systems; improving irrigation controls for water efficiency; and initiating continuous building commissioning. CSISD joins five other school districts and five other public institutions that are with the Rebuild Texas/Brazos Valley partnership. The partnership is proceeding with plans to

invest over \$11 million to retrofit 8.3 million square feet of facilities. They anticipate utility savings of over \$2.5 million per year with a payback period of just over four years.
