

Three communities are helping **Rebuild West Virginia** improve 600,000 square feet of Main Street building space, according to Monica Miller, state coordinator of Main Street West Virginia. **Main Street Ripley** is holding a workshop to incorporate the ongoing work on a city building and historic theater into its action plan. **Main Street Philippi** is currently auditing two buildings and recently met with community and business leaders to discuss Rebuild America. **Main Street Morgantown** has begun work on a historic hotel. Rebuild West Virginia's local partners have access to energy audits, technical assistance and a statewide network of experts. They are also eligible for financial assistance.
